## -a new opportunity to get involved in ending global hunger

Safu comes from a child headed family in central Malawi. She lost both parents to HIV AIDS and is alone raising her siblings. Her aunt escorted her to the food distribution funded by NCM Canada and Canadian Foodgrains Bank



Safu was in tears of joy after receiving her portion of food. She could not believe that this was real in her life because she and her siblings had gone for a month or more surviving through begging food. Their future looked very grim.

After receiving the food, Safu said "Now we will be able to go back to school. We won't have to spend all day begging or working on other people's farms in order to eat."

**Grow Hope Markdale** was formed to help such hungry people as Safu.

Grow Hope is a partnership of the Markdale Church of the Nazarene, Nazarene Compassionate Ministries Canada, and Canadian Foodgrains Bank. The Grow Hope partnership was formed to give more people, an opportunity to become involved in our efforts to end hunger.

## Here's how it works....

Anyone, urban or rural, church or non-churched can sponsor an acre\* of land provided by farmer Wayne Goudy and family, near Markdale, Ontario.

NCM Canada receives the donations and forwards them to the farmer who grows the crop – corn, wheat, soybeans or other.

The farmer harvests the crops and the money goes to Canadian Foodgrains Bank.

The Canadian Government (Global Affairs Canada) matches most such donations for food projects 4:1

The original donation is thus multiplied and goes to feed hungry people in our world.

\* an acre of land is about the size of a small soccer field or the size of a football field without the end zones

This year's crop is Spring Wheat. The cost for one acre of spring wheat is \$350. When harvested the spring wheat should yield about \$500 per acre. The money is sent to CFGB where it is matched 4:1. The funds are used to feed hungry people in our world.
